We are reaching out to former in-service members of NYSUT from our Retiree Council (Jefferson, Lewis, Franklin, St. Lawrence, Clinton, Essex and Warren Counties). You continue to be a member in retirement, thanks to work done by many of our colleagues in the 1980's.

When you retire from your LOCAL, your membership in NYSUT remains with you in retirement. The *Union for Life* slogan means just that. You pay no dues to NYSUT as a retiree.

NYSUT has one of the *most active and successful union retiree programs* in the country. The NYSUT Retiree Services Program, part of Program Services, was established by NYSUT to help its retirees organize and to act as a service provider for those retiree groups. In an effort to better serve the growing number of retirees, 11 Retiree Services Consultants have been hired to serve members in the field. These retiree consultants and your representatives have access to all of NYSUT Services, legal, legislative, PR, Health Services Consultant, IT, Political Action and more. **Chris Fowler** is coming on board in July as our Consultant replacing Ruth Shippee.

As a retiree, you are represented at the NYSUT RA by retiree delegates, who also elect Board members to the NYSUT Board of Directors, elected from our **Retiree Council 9**. RC-9 expands across the North Country from Watertown area to Plattsburgh and down to Glens Falls. The district is so large that we have 4 sub-councils (see below). At the NYSUT RA, policies that drive NYSUT and its foci are selected and we make sure that retiree concerns and issues are addressed by our Union.

Retiree Council 9 collects an annual participation fee from members who join in our efforts to be your voice to work with NYSUT and our locals to protect your benefits and support public education and those who provide those services. This fee, \$20/year, is divided between RC 9 and your individual sub-council.
